## From the Station of Charity



Greetings fellow Elks from the station of Charity.

Our Lodge directly supports our two main Elks charitable outlets. The California Hawaii Elks Association (CHEA), and our Elks National Foundation (ENF). A few notes on ENF...

The mission of the Elks National Foundation is to help Elks build stronger communities. They fulfill this pledge by investing in communities where Elks live and work. They help youth develop lifelong skills, send students to college, meet the needs of today's veterans, support the charitable work of the state Elks associations, and fund projects that im-

prove the quality of life in local Elks communities. They contribute directly to our CHEMPI, as well as giving money directly back to our Lodge through grants.

Since inception, the ENF has contributed more than \$500 million toward Elks charitable projects nationwide, and this year will distribute 45.3 million nationwide. As I understand it, every dollar that we donate goes directly into their General Fund, and the distribution of funds comes directly from their interest and investment income. They will grant nearly \$10.7 million to the state Elks associations, which includes our CHEA.

Each year, the ENF strives to grant more money back to each state than it received from that state in donations. These grants help fund the state Elks associations' major charitable projects, which include aid for people with disabilities, cancer research, children's hospitals, youth camps, and safe havens for abused families. The state associations also use these grants to fund our Hoop Shoot, Drug Awareness, scholarship and veterans service programs, as well as other charitable and philanthropic projects. Let's all donate to the ENF. Charity is the cornerstone of every Elk structure, the highest virtue of every Elk creed.

# BLT NOW ASK ME HOW



#### The Bequest and Living Trust Overview

BLT is short for the Bequest and Living Trust Committee. The idea behind the BLT is to encourage all Elks to name the Major Project as a beneficiary of their Estate in any amount an Elk and spouse can afford. It is recognized that an Elk's first responsibility is to the family.

#### The purpose of Bequest and Living Trust



BLT was not begun as Building for the Future a replacement for the Piggy Bank Program but to work hand in hand with it. The aim of the BLT Committee is to insure the future of

the Major Project. To guarantee that future, the BLT Committee is seeking commitments from Elks and their spouses, stating that they have provided for a distribution from their estate (upon their death) to continue the good works of the Major Project. Giving to the Major Project through BLT is not limited to Elks alone. Anyone can direct that a charitable gift be given to CHEMPI from their Estate.

#### The BLT Benefactor Program

The Benefactor Program was formed to recognize Elks, their spouses and others who have made a commitment to the Major Project either through their wills or through a direct donation. All gifts made through the BLT Benefactor program will be invested prudently to obtain maximum growth.

The BLT Benefactor Program is designed to make it easy and affordable for everyone to give. With tax benefits to the donor and immeasurable benefits to disabled children.

#### The BLT Commitment Trust Program

The Commitment Trust is a charitable remainder unitrust (UT) which pays 7% of the trust value each year for as long as the donor or spouse is living. When both of you have passed on, the value of the trust is transferred to the Major Project program. There is a \$10,000 minimum to establish a commitment trust.

Based upon your ages, a \$10,000 commitment trust will create an immediate income tax deduction. The final deduction amount depends upon time of creation of the trust since your ages and IRS' monthly factor impact the deduction calculation.


## **Culver City Elks Donate to the Community**


